#### Allied forces scenario notes:

1. Australian and British forces begin the game with forces deployed in BOTH their front and reserve lines. GWSH Rule 15.2.6 'Wave Attacks' must be used.
2. The British 184th Brigade is deployed on the allied right. The operational boundary between the 184th Brigade, and the Australian 15th Brigade (which should be deployed immediately

to the left of the 184<sup>th</sup>) is a line 3' for the right edge of the table (from the allied perspective - this is the left edge of the table as it appears on the map below).

3. So the allied Brigade deployment order from right to left is:  
184<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>.
4. While the Australian 5<sup>th</sup> Division was inexperienced (this was it's first battle) the performance of the troops on the day was not consistent with Green troops. They are therefore classified as Regular.
