

Up the River to Nasiriyeh, July 1915 Turkish OOB

Set Up

- The Turkish deployment area is marked on the map.
- At least one regiment must be set up on the southern side of the river.
- The Turks have four 6” sections of Level 1 trenches, any two of these sections may be wired. They can be deployed at player discretion within the Turkish deployment area, but two sections must be north of the river and the other two sections south of the river. These two sections can be deployed as one 12” section or two separate 6” sections.
- The Turkish player is allowed to position ONE anti-shipping blockade anywhere across the Euphrates within the Turkish set up area. This blockade is DEF6, and would be destroyed after 1D6 hits by artillery guns, determined by the umpire. If an umpire is not available, then the Turkish player should roll the die for the number of hits required to destroy the blockade AFTER it receives its first hit. Alternatively river raft may pass the barricade by spending one complete move halted, without firing, at the barricade.

- (1) One artillery regiment is on table, either brigaded or dispersed into separate batteries. The other regiment can be on table (either brigaded or in batteries) or off table at player discretion. Each artillery battery or regiment has 8 fire missions.
- (2) Treat the Budhoos as having same attributes as Turkish 3rd Line Reserves.
- (3) There is **no** additional variable strength die roll for the Turkish forces.
